Governance:

Technical Advisory Committee

- Representation from various government departments
- Formed to provide technical guidance to process
- Has met 14 times since study initiated

Community Advisory Committee

- First met in October 2007
 - Cross section of the Flin Flon & Creighton communities
 - Formed to provide public input to process
 - Has met 7 times to date
