## Exposure Study Proposal

- Following the IERP, the Provincial Government Health representatives of the TAC recommended that the study proceed. The TAC approved the recommendation.
  - Based on the discussions at the IERP, the risk models will need to be adjusted.
  - The specific chemicals of concern to include in the study need to be confirmed.
  - A decision on the requirements, if any, for a control group need to be made.
  - The CAC should be made aware that the recommendation to proceed has been made, but that the scope still needs to be finalized (see action #127).
  - The study will be submitted for ethics review next week.
  - The sub-committee needs to flesh out the recommendation (see action #128).
