Introduction

- The agenda was reviewed and accepted.
- The notes from the March 5th meeting were reviewed and approved. The action items from the previous meeting were updated.

Final Comments on Draft Report and Appendices

- The need for further bio-monitoring was discussed. The Committee decided that further monitoring would not be necessary unless there was a significant change to community exposure.
- Discussion then turned to other routine monitoring programs and how ongoing work should be managed. Consensus was that the Risk Management Plan (RMP) should dictate future monitoring requirements. The RMP should be overseen by the existing Joint Regulatory Group (JRG) which has historically dealt with similar issues at the Hudbay Metallurgical Complex.

Confirmation of Date and Plans for Flin Flon Open House; Communication with the CAC

- The date of the Flin Flon Open House was confirmed as May 14, 2013.
- Preparation activities for the Flin Flon Open House were reviewed:
 - Intrinsic would prepare a plain language two-page handout for review by Manitoba and Saskatchewan Health officials (New Actions 13-07, 13-08).
 - Hudbay and Manitoba Health would arrange to conduct a radio interview / Q&A session (New Action 13-09).
 - The Flin Flon Soils Survey website would be updated (New Action 13-10).
 - Hudbay would look after general arrangements for the Open House (New Action 13-11).
- The future role of the Community Advisory Committee (CAC) was discussed. At this time, the CAC feels that their role has been fulfilled. Representatives will attend the Open House.
- The Committee discussed revival of the annual air quality meeting as part of the Healthy Flin Flon program. It was decided that future presentations would resume at that venue.
