#### Introduction

The agenda was reviewed and accepted.

• The notes from the February 24 meeting were not accepted. The notes will be revised and redistributed for off-line review and approval.

#### **Status of Documents**

- The draft Exposure Study Report and related documents were discussed.
  - The report was sent to two separate peer reviewers. Comments have been received from one of these reviewers while the other is expected later this week.
  - Based on the peer review and TAC comments received to date and the ones expected from the second peer reviewer, the revised report is targeted for completion by May 11.
  - The evaluation of exposure study summary for the bridge document was provided to Intrinsik last week. A plain language document and a one-page summary were also provided.
- The HHRA report is essentially complete.
  - The document is being checked for final references, etc.

Question: Has the 2<sup>nd</sup> objective of the HHRA been sufficiently addressed in the executive

summary?

Response: Intrinsik believes that the objective has been addressed but will check the executive

summary to confirm (see action #161).

- The bridge document is being rewritten based on comment received to date. The next draft is expected by next week.
- The 4-pager is almost ready for circulation. It should be distributed either today or tomorrow.

## Risk Management

- The Government representatives have a meeting planned for later this week to discuss risk management strategies. Follow-up with HBMS personnel will occur after this meeting.
  - If possible and available, these representatives would like to have the recommendation section of the bridge document for this meeting.

### **Communication Plan**

 The draft communication plan was discussed at a meeting of the Communication Working Group last week. Based on comments received at that meeting, the plan is under revision. It is anticipated that the plan will continue to be revised based on ongoing comments from the TAC, CAC and CWG.

### **Overall Schedule**

- The schedule has been revised to postpone the Open House from May 20 to June 17. All other major milestone dates remain in place to avoid further slippage.
  - The planned CAC workshop content may need to be revised slightly to accommodate the overall schedule change. A rough approach for the workshop will be prepared and circulated to the TAC for comment (see action #162).
