Introduction

- The agenda was reviewed and accepted.
- The approval of the notes from the May 13 was deferred to the next meeting on June 8th.

Status of Documents

- The status of the various documents was discussed.
 - Some additional questions were submitted by members of the CAC for potential inclusion in the Q&A document. Individuals were assigned to provide answers to these questions. The document will be re-circulated by George later today (see action #166). The individuals assigned have until the end of next week to provide answers to the questions (see action #165). As previously noted, the final document may be split into an internal Q&A document and a posted FAQ document.
 - The latest draft of the evaluation of exposure study report was sent for comment on May 21. Final comments are required by Monday (see action #167).
 - The three revised chapters of the HHRA that were circulated on May 11 must be commented on quickly to allow time for printing before the Open House (see action #168).
 - The latest version of the "4-pager" was circulated on May 25. This document needs to be sent for printing next week. Some government personnel indicated that further review of the document is required within their organizations. A quick turn-around is required to meet printing deadlines (see actions #169 & 170).
 - The summary (bridge) document will be re-circulated for final comment early next week. Comments are required by the end of the week (see actions #171 & 172).
 - A question was raised regarding the air conclusions, as currently written. A slight re-wording will be made in the bridge document (see action #173).

Open House

- The floor plan / outline for the Open House was distributed prior to the meeting. Although the CWG will address the details, some comments were made:
 - There needs to be adequate seating for audience members for the presentations.
 - The presentation should focus mainly on results and less on the other components.
 - Care should be taken to ensure information is not repeated by each presenter.
 - The HBMS presentation should be last.

- Susan will not be participating. Lawrence and James will cover the Health Departments.
- Health Canada is not sending a representative.
- Presentation material should be reviewed. The Intrinsic material content will be close to the content of the 4-pager and will be circulated for comment (see action #174).
